



Turn your phone into a modem connection with a Laptop

To connect using USB cable

- Step 1: Connect the device to laptop via the **USB cable**.
- Step 2: Click on **Start**.
- Step 3: Select **Control Panel**.
- Step 4: Select **Phone and Modem Options**.
- Step 5: Select **Modems** Tab.
- Step 6: Select **Motorola USB Modem** and click on **Properties**.
- Step 7: Select **Diagnostics** Tab.
- Step 8: Click on **Query Modem**.
- Step 9: Select **Advanced** Tab.
- Step 10: Enter **at+cgdcont=1,"ip","unet"** into the **Extra initialization commands:** field.
- Step 11: Click **Ok** twice.
- Step 12: On the **Control Panel**, select **Network Connections**.
- Step 13: Select **Create a new connection** and click **Next**.
- Step 14: Select **Connect to the Internet** and click **Next**.
- Step 15: Select **Set up my connection manually** and click **Next**.
- Step 16: Select **Connect using a dial-up modem** and click **Next**.
- Step 17: Ensure that the **Modem – Motorola USB Modem** is **checked** and the rest unchecked and click **Next**.
- Step 18: Enter an **ISP Name** and click **Next**.
- Step 19: Enter ***99#** in the **Phone number:** field and click **Next**.
- Step 20: Select **My use only** and click **Next**.
- Step 21: Enter **maxis** into the **Username:** field.
- Step 22: Enter **wap** into the **Password:** field.
- Step 23: Ensure that all checked box are **Unchecked** and click **Next**.
- Step 24: Click **Finish**.
- Step 25: A pop-up will appeared, click **Dial** to connect.
- Step 26: Well Done! You have successfully connected as a modem.
