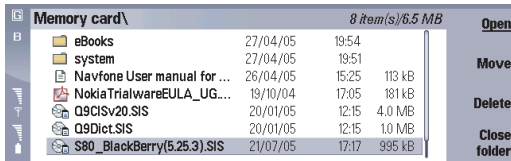


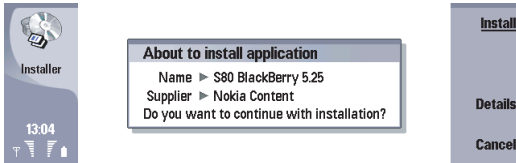

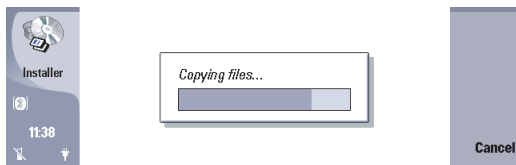
Installing BlackBerry Client onto the Nokia 9300/ 9500



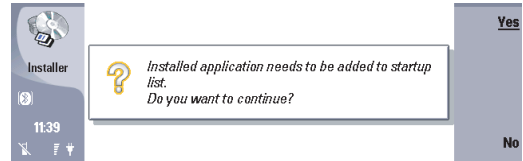
1. Insert the memory card into the device and go to File Manager by browsing from Desk > Office > File Manager. The BlackBerry client is named S80_Blackberry(5.25.3).SIS and is located in the root directory.



2. Select the sis file S80_Blackberry(5.25.3).SIS and click on OPEN, which will load up the installer. Click on “Install”



3. The application will start installing.



4. Some files need to be added to the startup list, so click on “Yes” to continue.



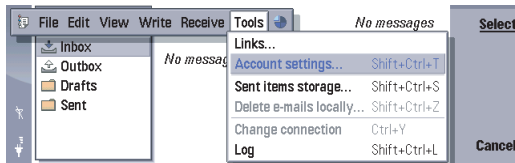
5. Installation completes. The BlackBerry client is now installed into your device memory.

Note: BlackBerry service is operator dependent and the availability of the application may vary according to your country or sales area. You need to subscribe to your operator or service provider's BlackBerry network service to be able to use the BlackBerry client. Check with your operator or service provider for more details.

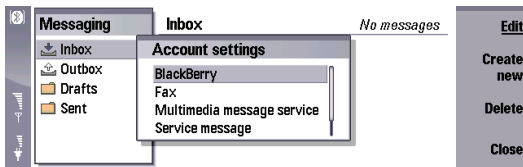
Creating the Blackberry Inbox in Messaging



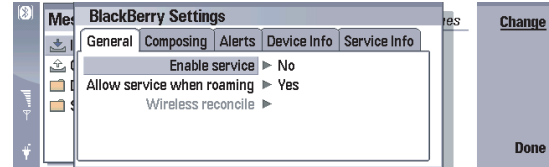
1. Messaging Inbox will not contain any "Blackberry" inbox.



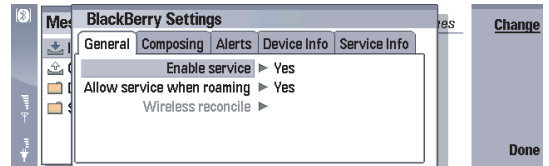
2. While in Messaging, click on Menu > Tools and select "Account Settings"



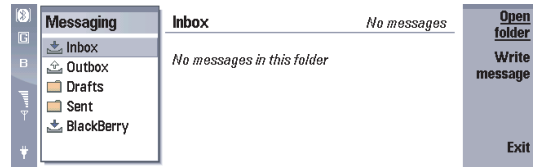
3. Select "Blackberry" and click "Edit"



4. The Blackberry settings page appears.



5. In the General Tab, change "Enable service" option to "Yes". Click on "Done" and exit BlackBerry Settings.



6. Upon exiting the Blackberry Settings page, a GPRS connection will be made automatically and the Blackberry "B" sign will appear, indicating a successful connection to the network.
